





Early Morning

Head to Hampstead Heath and watch the city come to life from Parliament Hill. It's the best spot for watching the sunrise.

Not quite wide awake? Start your day with a walk across Hyde Park Catch the tube to Hyde Park corner and take a diagonal route via the Serpentine lake to Bayswater Road and Kensington Gardens.

Alternatively, learn more about the United Kingdom's most famous family with a visit to one of these royal attractions. The Tower of London houses the Crown Jewels, Kensington Place is the home of Diana Princess of Wales, Princess Margaret and Queen Victoria and the Queen's official residence Buckingham Palace opens its staterooms between August and September each year.

The Changing of the guards takes place from 11:30 and finishes around midday.

Afternoon

Opt for a quick lunch then sit back and relax on a sightseeing tour. The Original London Sightseeing Tour takes place on an open top double decker bus. The hop on, hop off ticket includes a free Thames River cruise.

Evening

Get up high and watch the city turn from day to night. There are plenty of affordable ways to see London from above including the 311 steps to the top of The Monument a Doric column built to commemorate the Great Fire of London.

The London Eye - a giant 135 metre Ferris wheel, affords amazing river and skyline views.

Relative newcomer The Shard building has the highest observation deck at a height of 244 metres.

Round off the evening with a trip to a traditional London pub. Many are located in centuries old buildings and every neighbourhood has its favourites like the notorious White Hart on Drury Lane. If you fancy heading out to the Docklands to see a show at the O2, drop in to the NY-LON a new bar that celebrates Virgin Atlantic's partnership with Delta Air Lines.

Still awake? Check out Karaoke Box in Soho or a late night show at Leicester Squares Odeon theatre. Finish off the night in one of the capitals all night dining establishments like the Heron Tower in Bishopsgate for a final splurge on Champagne cocktails and smoked salmon at the Duck and Waffle.






